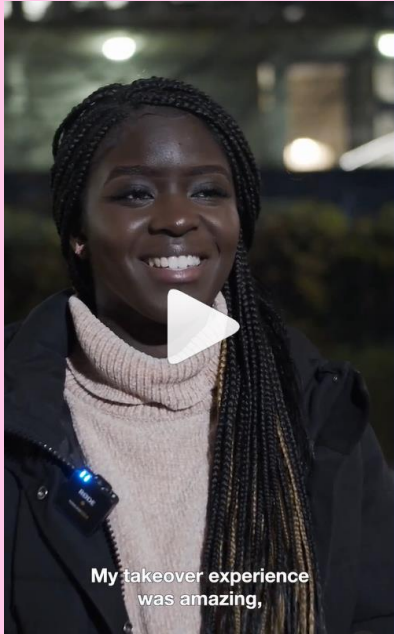

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What will the Girls Takeover experience involve?

Girls Takeover is a day-in-the-life of a senior leader, so no two Girls Takeover experiences are the same! Typically, a takeover day involves:

- Spending time with the leader whose role you are taking over to learn from their experience of what it takes to run a company or work in politics.
- You may join a Board Meeting or a panel discussion to discuss the barriers girls face at school, or in society, in their choices for study and jobs and you might share what young people want their future careers to look like - what excites and motivates them.
- You will meet other senior female leaders, or from women just starting their careers, to hear how they navigated challenges and opportunities.
- You could brainstorm new ideas with the design team, the research and development team or explore a production line.

The most important thing about a Girls Takeover experience is being yourself; we just want you to feel comfortable and confident in taking part. We'll also make sure that Plan International UK are with you each step of the way to support you.

Can I share ideas for the Girls Takeover experience?

Yes! The Girls Takeover experiences will already have loose schedules based on the day-in-the-life of the leader whose role is being taken over – but we will work with you to make sure the day includes activities you are interested in.

Do I have to know what I want to do as my future career to take part in a Girls Takeover?

No, not at all! Girls Takeover is an opportunity to experience leadership in different career paths, but you don't have to already know what career path you might want to take part.

How much time will the Girls Takeover experience take?

Each experience is unique, but most will take place during a “working day”, typically 9am to 5pm on a weekday. Ahead of the takeover experience, there will also be a couple of phone/ video calls with the Girls Takeover team at Plan International UK to help you prepare for the takeover, which will be arranged at a time that suits you. We will also speak with you after the takeover to get your feedback.

Can I receive support with my application?

Can I request support or adjustments to take part in Girls Takeover?

Yes. At Plan International UK we want to make sure you feel comfortable, confident and prepared for your day and know that this is different for everyone, we want to remove any barriers we can so you can take part. Can I apply for more than one Girls Takeover opportunity?

Yes! You can apply for as many Girls Takeover opportunities as you like. If you are successful for one Girls Takeover, you will only take part in that event this year.

Can I apply for a Girls Takeover even if I don't live nearby where it is taking place?

Yes! Plan International UK will pay for your travel to the event, including staying overnight before and/or after the event if you are travelling a long distance. We will also pay for your parent/caregiver to travel with you if needed.

What support will I get to take part in Girls Takeover?

The Girls Takeover team at Plan International UK will help you every step of the way! Before the takeover experience, we will plan the agenda for the day together; help you prepare any presentations or conversation topics to have with the leaders you will meet; join you on a video call with the leader to meet them ahead of the day; help organise travel; let you know what to bring for the day and discuss the dress code.

On the takeover day itself, a member of the Plan International UK team will be with you throughout the whole experience – think of us as your Personal Assistant!

What will happen after the Girls Takeover experience?

After the day, you will meet with the Girls Takeover team at Plan International UK to share your experiences and discuss how you can follow up on anything that you discussed with your senior leader on the day. We will also stay in touch to share further opportunities with you.

Do I have to have my photograph taken to take part in a Girls Takeover?

Plan International UK and the organisations taking part would like to share information about the takeover experiences on social media, websites and in the media (e.g. newspapers) to celebrate International Day of the Girl (11th October). However, you do not have to have your photograph/ video taken to take part in all of the Girls Takeovers. We will advertise which takeovers must involve photography/video consent (i.e. a social media takeover).

Before the takeover event, we will ask for your consent to take your photograph or include you in filming/interviews. After the event, we will ask for your consent to use the photos/video footage.

Will I meet the leader before the day itself?

Yes, the Girls' Takeover team will arrange a pre-takeover call with you, the leader and a member of the Girls' Takeover team at Plan International UK. This will most likely take place as a video call one week before the takeover.

Will I be going to the Girls Takeover by myself or with other people?

Most Girls Takeover experiences are for one young person only. However, you will be accompanied by a member of the Girls Takeover team at Plan International UK throughout the whole day, and you will never be left alone.

Will I get paid for taking part in Girls Takeover?

No, this is not a paid opportunity. Plan International UK will pay for all your travel, food and accommodation (if needed due to travelling a long distance).

Do I have to act or dress a certain way on a takeover day?

A takeover day is about you being yourself and speaking up for girls like you. All you have to do is to come with an open mind and ideas for the day. The dress code is relaxed but if you're worried about what to wear you can speak to a member of our team.
